### \$2,500 FRS Scholarship

The Foundation for Rural Service (FRS), a branch of the National Telephone Cooperative Association, is offering 30 scholarships nationwide. These scholarships are \$2,000 each, and all high school seniors whose parents are a member of West River Cooperative Telephone Company (WRCTC) are eligible to apply.

Should a student from our service area be selected to receive one of the 30 scholarships, WRCTC will make a \$500 matching contribution to the scholarship, bringing the total scholarship award to \$2,500! Preference will be given to individuals expressing an interest in returning to work in a rural area following college graduation.

Applications are 456-2266 available online at www.wrctc. coop, through the Guidance Counselor at your school or from WRCTC in Bison. Completed applications require the signature of General Manager Jerry Reisenauer PRIOR to March 1, 2013, to ensure applications are postmarked to FRS before the deadline.
